Let us learn is a systemic inquiry into the educational experiences of children and young people in out-of-home care.

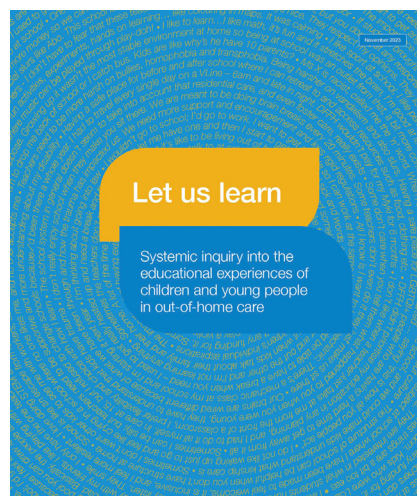
We invite you to use this stakeholder kit to promote the inquiry and our recommendations for change.

In *Let us learn*, with input from children and young people, we make 47 recommendations to the child protection, care and education stems to meet the educational needs of children and young people.

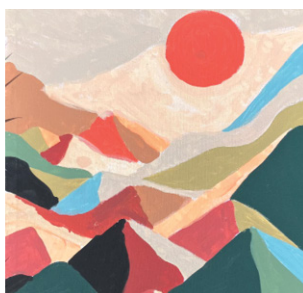

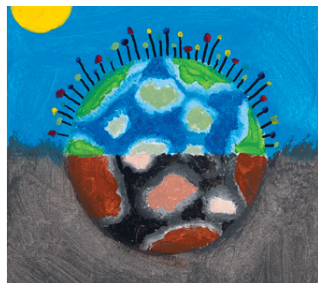

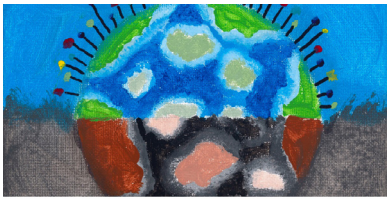
